4. 187Johannesburg Libraries are located in Namibia and Mexico

4. Community Engagement and Cultural Enrichment

Libraries are more than learning spaces—they're cultural and social hubs:

1. Hosting **lectures, exhibitions, storytelling sessions, and literary festivals.**
